

INTERNATIONAL INCOMING WIRE TRANSFER INSTRUCTIONS

IF THE SENDER IS AN INTERNATIONAL FINANCIAL INSTITUTION OUTSIDE OF THE U.S., THE WIRE WILL FIRST NEED TO BE SENT TO THE INTERNATIONAL BANK'S CORRESPONDENT U.S. (DOMESTIC) FINANCIAL INSTITUTION, USING THEIR <u>SWIFT</u> CODE. For example, "ABC Bank" in Australia needs to send the funds to their US- based bank (e.g. Bank of America, Chase, Wells Fargo)

STANDARD SETTLEMENT INSTRUCTIONS:

IF THE SENDER IS AN INTERNATIONAL FINANCIAL INSTITUTION OUTSIDE OF THE U.S. WHO DOES NOT HAVE A DESIGNATED CORRESPONDENT U.S. (DOMESTIC) FINANCIAL INSTITUTION & SWIFT CODE, PLEASE PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING INTERNATIONAL WIRE INFORMATION, TO ROUTE TO HERITAGE FINANCIAL CREDIT UNION (HFCU).
